



Clinical Therapist Job Description

Job Title: Clinical Therapist

Position Description: The Therapist will provide person-centered, trauma focused in-home behavioral health services to individuals and families who are experiencing various behavioral health challenges.

Major Areas of Responsibility:

- Provide person-centered and trauma focused in-home mental health therapy to individuals and families according to their recovery plan.
- Complete clinical documentation within 48 hours of date of service (recommended to be completed daily).
- Perform and develop person-centered clinical assessments/reassessments and recovery plans.
- Arrange schedule around individuals and families receiving services. Hours can be between 8a-8p seven days a week.
- Ability to engage in a minimum one hour of clinical supervision a month. Can be conducted in-person, FaceTime, or Zoom.
- Responsiveness to the recovery team (attorney's, GAL's, Social worker, etc.) via email and telephone inquiries.
- Maintain good standing with the appropriate licensing board(s) and insurance entities.
- Stay current with updated research and best practices.
- Be familiar with community referral sources and referral processes.
- Ability to document according to billing clinical and billing standards. Must sign a business associate agreement.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Trauma certification or at least one-year experience utilizing trauma specific modalities. If no certification, you must have some documented training in trauma and at least two years with direct practice of trauma informed care.
- Proof of current person-centered treatment training and care.
- Knowledge of family systems and their impact on mental health within the family.
- Skill in applying varied interventions with individuals/families in crisis.
- Skill in working independently and implementing time management strategies.
- Ability to provide necessary self-care.
- Ability to demonstrate positive team interactions with other therapists.
- Awareness of personal strengths and appropriate timing for referrals.
- Own or have access to a vehicle with valid vehicle insurance and license. All services are performed in the home and community.

Education and Experience:

- A masters or doctoral degree in a mental health-related field.
- Must hold an independent or graduate level license and become emplanated with at least three insurance companies (once hired).
- Previous experience in home-based mental health, and/or knowledge of electronic medial record are desirable but not required.
